

Joseph Smith's First Vision

James 1:5 - Analysis

"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."

Didn't Joseph Smith do the right thing?

Knowledge = knowing something; receiving an answer or some kind of information

Wisdom = Proper application of knowledge



Biblical Response



Mark 13:31 "Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away."

Something only needs to be restored if it previously passed away.

Jude 1:3 "Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you contend earnestly for **the faith that was once for all time handed down to the saints.**"

Something that was delivered once and for all will not be delivered a second time/restored.



Biblical Response




Matthew 16:18 "And I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hell will not overpower it."

Joseph Smith claimed that the gates of hell did overpower the church.











Plan of Salvation

We can become Gods

John 10:34 "Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your Law, 'I have said you are **"gods,"**"

Psalm 82:6 "I said, 'You are **"gods"**; you are all sons of the Most High."

1 Corinthians 8:5b "there are many "gods" and many "lords."

"There is more than 1 God, but Jesus is the 1 God that we worship."







We can become Gods

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Sound Biblical Hermeneutics

- God presides in the great assembly; he renders judgment among the "gods":
- ² "How long will you defend the unjust and show partiality to the wicked?
- ³ Defend the weak and the fatherless; uphold the cause of the poor and the oppressed.
- 4 Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked.
- 5 "The 'gods' know nothing, they understand nothing. They walk about in darkness; all the foundations of the earth are shaken.
- 6 "I said, 'You are "gods"; you are all sons of the Most High.'
- ⁷ But you will die like mere mortals; you will fall like every other ruler."
- 8 Rise up, O God, judge the earth, for all the nations are your inheritance.

We can become Gods

John 10:34 Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your Law, 'I have said you are "gods," $^{\prime\prime}$

Psalm 82:6 "I said, 'You are "gods"; you are all sons of the Most High."

What is the context of Psalm 82? God is judging wicked earthly kings.



1 Corinthians 8:4 "So then, about eating food sacrificed to **idols**: We know that "An **idol** is nothing at all in the world" and that "There is **no God but one."**

Paul is referring to false idols as gods and lords.

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Psalm 89:27 "And I will appoint him to be my <u>firstborn</u>, the most exalted of the kings of the earth."

- Who is this talking about?

Psalm 89:20 "I have found <u>David</u> my servant; with my sacred oil I have anointed him."


- Why is David referred to as God's firstborn?

Psalm 89:27 "And I will appoint him to be my firstborn, the most exalted of the kings of the earth."

- Firstborn = preeminent / supreme / highest in rank

Same context is applied to Jesus in Colossians 1:15.

"The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation."






LDS Biblical Support

John 20:17 Jesus said, "Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God."

Jesus calls the Father: God

Jesus has a God???

Hebrews 1:8 "But about the **Son** he says, "Your throne, **O God**, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom."



3. There always has been and always will be 1 God







LDS Gospel

Moroni 10:32 "Yea, come unto Christ, and be perfected in him, and deny yourselves of all ungodliness; and if ye shall deny yourselves of all ungodliness, and love God with all your might, mind and strength, then is his grace sufficient for you, that by his grace ye may be perfect in Christ;"

- 2 Nephi 25:23 "for we know that it is by grace that we are saved, after all we can do."
- 1 Nephi 3:7 "For I know that the Lord giveth no commandments unto the children of men, save he shall prepare a way for them that they may accomplish the thing which he commandeth them."

LDS Gospel

D&C 58:43 "By this ye may know if a man <u>repenteth</u> of his sins—behold, he will confess them and **forsake them**."

LDS Church Website Jesus paid for our sins, but they are not removed from us unless we repent. When Alma was describing how he recognized and repented of his sins, he said:

D&C 82:7 "And now, verily I say unto you, I, the Lord, will not lay any sin to your charge; go your ways and sin no more; but **unto that soul who sinneth shall the former sins return**, saith the Lord your God."

LDS Gospel

"As long I am doing my striving to do my best, that's all I can do."

Spencer Kimball - Book: Miracle of Forgiveness; Chapter Title: Trying Is Not Sufficient - "When one "merely tries" to abandon sin, then they haven't completely repented. Trying is OK for children, but adults must DO. **To 'try' is weak. To 'do the best I can' is not strong**."

"The forsaking of sin **must be a permanent one**. True repentance does not permit making the same mistake again."
